ROBOTIC EXOSKELETON ADVANCES HEALTHY AGING

The Army Distaff Foundation (ADF) is the first life plan community in the nation to deploy the EksoGT[™], a robotic exoskeleton device used for physical therapy. The more than 25 men and women who have volunteered to use this cutting-edge technology are pioneers forging a path toward strength for themselves and new possibilities for others.

In February 2018, ADF made a bold commitment to explore the power of this high-tech physical therapy device. Guided by our status as a 501(c)(3) non-profit and our military spirit, we looked beyond its use with combat soldiers and spinal cord injury victims to innovate new applications for older people with compromised mobility. The EksoGT[™] is helping people confront personal challenges and achieve a range of goals to improve their lives.

The EksoGT[™] has had a tremendous impact on the health and

well-being of Sybil Marks. A history of stroke affected the entire right side of her body. After just 11 months of EksoGT[™] therapy, she has experienced:

- Regained independence leading to improved quality of life
- Return of sensation to a leg that had lost feeling
- Increased lower body strength that helped her stand unsupported and walk 500 feet with minimal assistance

The effects of transverse myelopathy, a condition that prevents nerves from efficiently stimulating muscles, left Tanya Soriano at an increased risk of falling, struggling with mobility and beginning to lose her independence. After just 6 months of EksoGT[™] therapy, she has experienced:
